Uses: A best choice for Sod Production, over seeding and new construction of other high quality Bluegrass turf. COURTYARD also can be used as a dense, attractive first cut rough to contrast Bentgrass fairways. This is an excellent choice for over seeding of high maintenance Bluegrass athletic fields. When used in a program of high fertility and managed soil Ph., it will spread and withstand cleat wear, traffic and mechanical damage. As a "Midnight type", COURTYARD can facilitate genetic breadth in bluegrass blends by using 3 or 4 "types" as grouped by Rutgers University in yearly updated categories.

Geographical Adaptation: COURTYARD will thrive throughout the range of Kentucky bluegrasses adaptation. Due to its strong genetic breadth it has adaptability in the Northern quarter of the transition zone under appropriate management.

Features: COURTYARD features medium-fine texture, very dark green color, resistance to stem rust and drought pressure. A top 5 performer for % living ground cover in summer. Dense turf with the excellent potential to withstand 1/2" height of cut, and offers rhizomatous repair of damaged areas for the customer who unquestionably wants the highest quality obtainable.
